3. The Context

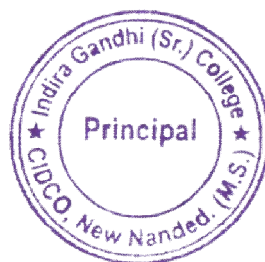
