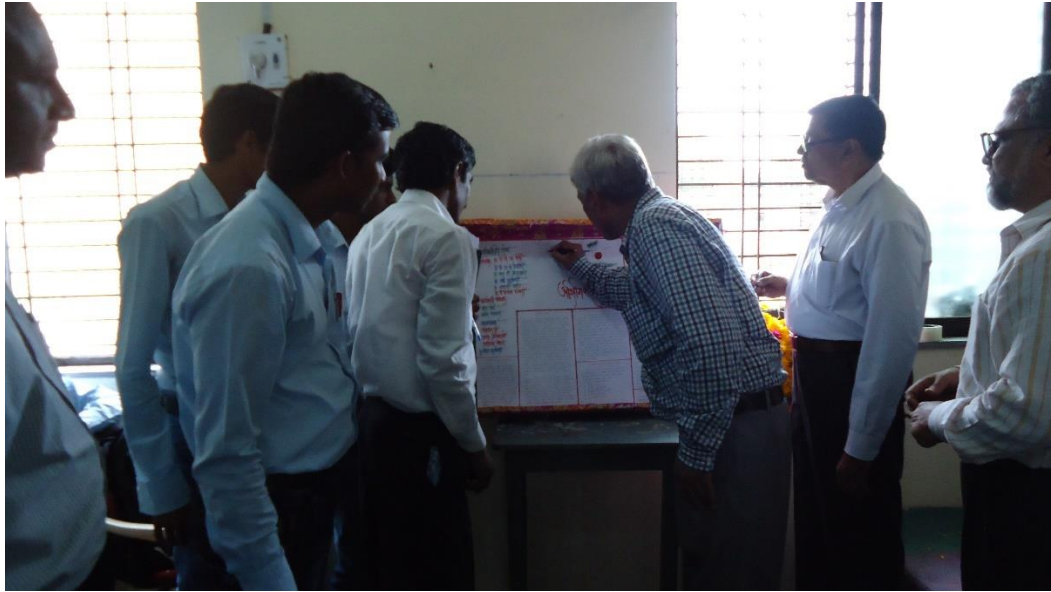
Research and Field Visit Activity:
