### **Resoponse:**

IQAC is established on **15th June, 2013** to monitor smooth functioning of all the curricular and extra-curricular activities run by the college. It plays significant role to improve the teaching-learning process. It conducts the meeting at regular intervals. It circulates its plans and perspectives to all the stakeholders. It collects the record from time to time and maintains the documents. IQAC also collects and analyses feedback from students, alumni and parents. The college reviews its teaching learning process, structures and methodologies of operations and learning outcomes at periodic intervals through IQAC set up as per norms and recorded the incremental improvements in various activities. IQAC plays significant role in introducing and implementing new policies related to quality education. It conducts, at least, four meetings annually to discuss all the topics of college and student welfare. It proposes starting of new academic ventures and research related activities.

The measures have been taken by IQAC in quality enhancement to improve the quality education in the college.

3. The IQAC works for maintaining discipline, monitoring feedback, monitoring students' attendance, conducting the unit tests / exams, framing faculty-wise time -table, ascertain DTR, Self-Appraisal and PBAS proforma, departmental profiles etc.
4. The IQAC updates itself regarding changes taking place in the teaching learning process by attending workshops and seminars, through library and internet sources, visiting the centers of excellence and compare them with the quality process in the college.
5. It organizes conferences, workshops, seminars, webinars and training programmes regarding staff development.
