Principal-Students Interaction Committee Report (2020-2021)

One of the highlighting activities in the college is Principal-Student interaction. In this programme, there is free and healthy interaction between principal and students on different levels. It has proved meaningful every year. Student had free dialogue with their beloved principal without any indecision. This programme is organized every year strictly on 14th August, eve on Independence Day irrespective of holiday. Programme is runs about two to three hours every year. Dr. Gajanan B. Zore in his Inaugural Speech interacted the students on the aspects of development and commercialization of biotechnological products and




various skills of commercialization by giving various examples. He motivated students to develop skills for future India.

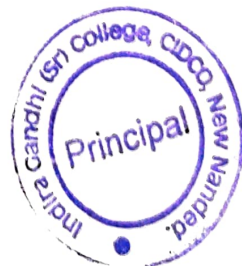

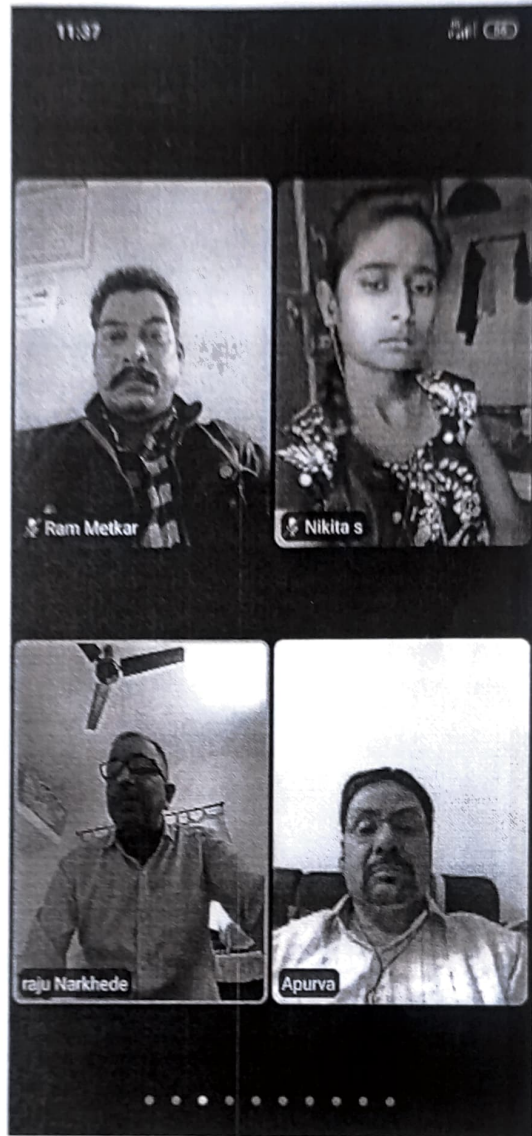

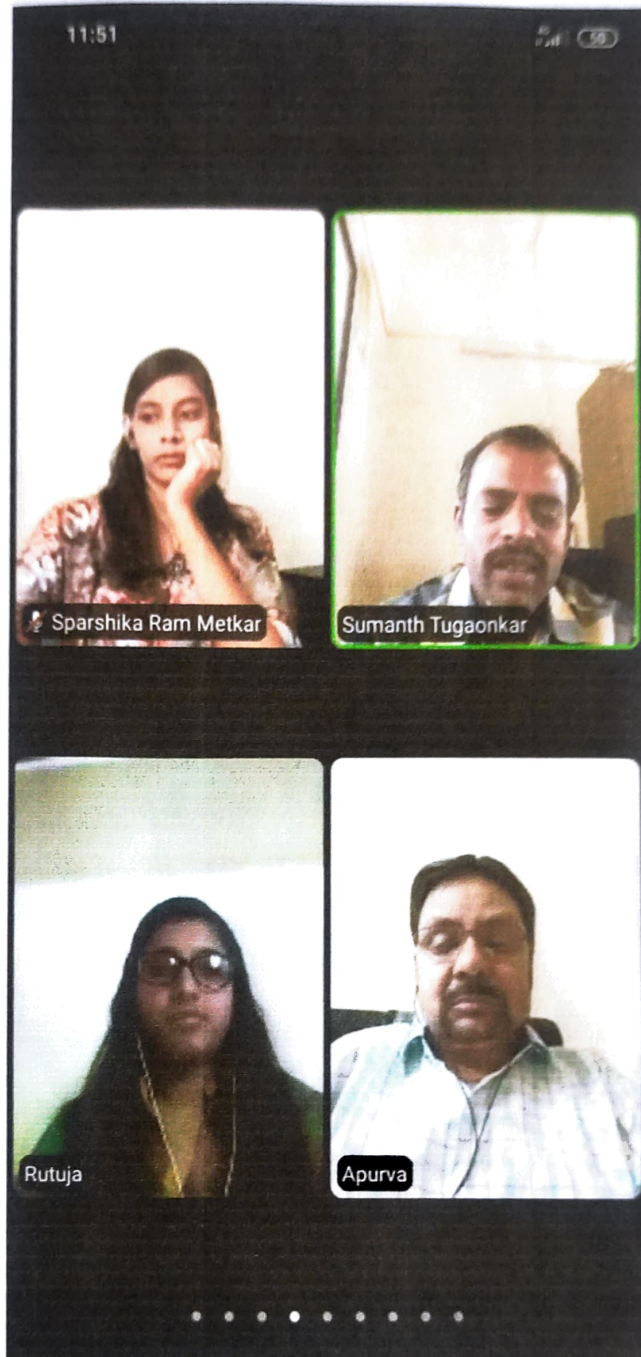
