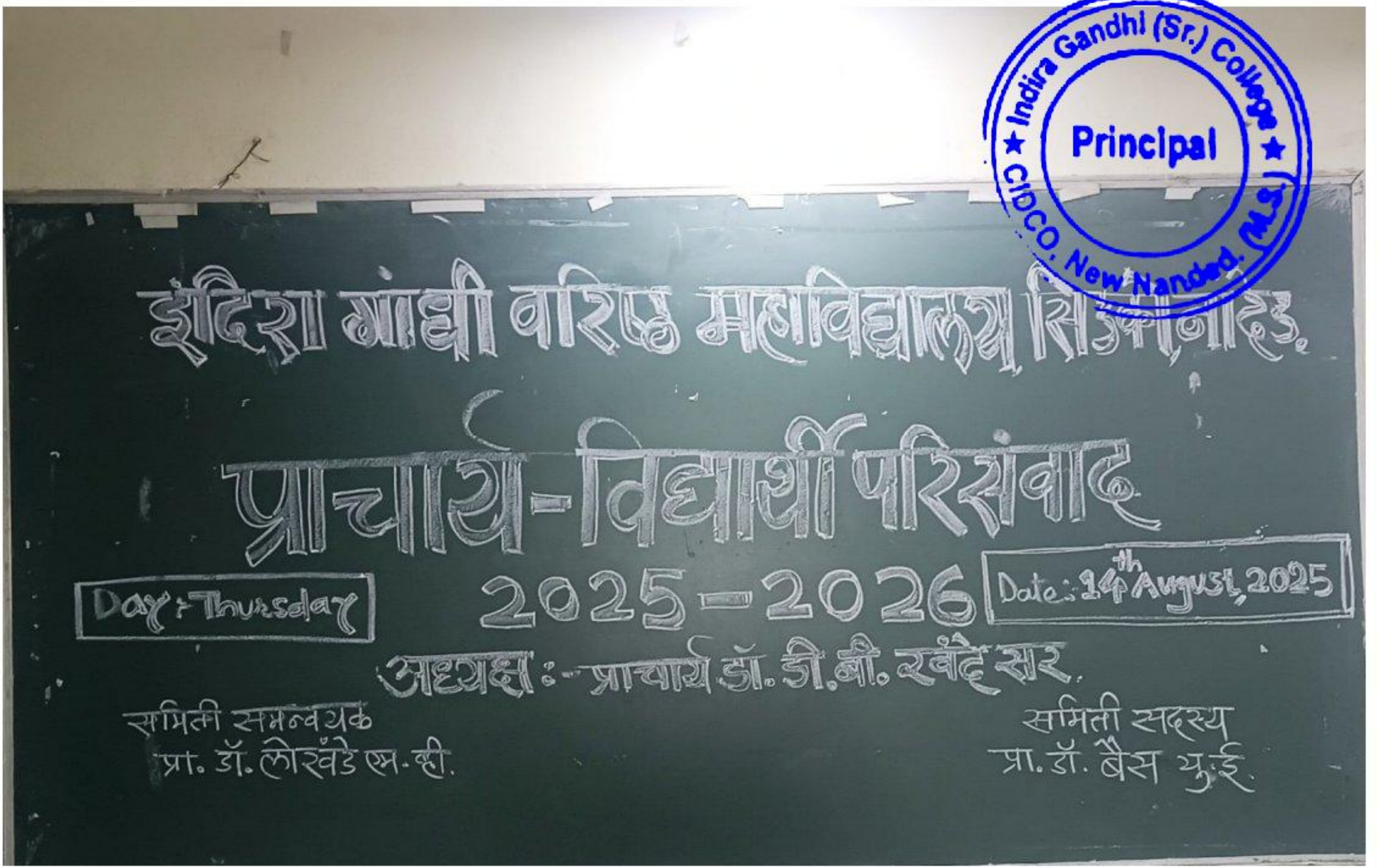

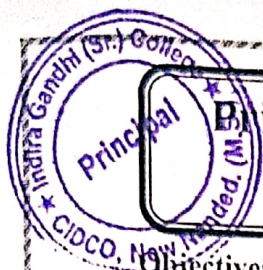

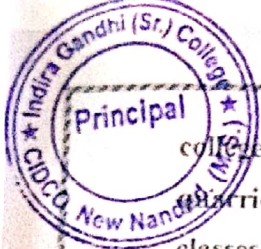
Context:

This interface programme was anchored and vote of thanks given by Dr. Lokhande M.V. (Coordinator Principal-Student Interaction Committee 2025-2026)

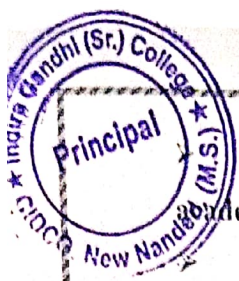
Evidence of Successes

➤ Regular cleaning and sanitation of the classroom and campus was done under the guidance of Honorable Principal.

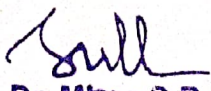


As per the demand of the students college has been purchased reference and academic books for the students in this year.
