After Valedictory function, online quiz was conducted. The 71 participants were completed programme successfully and distributed their certificate on programme Whatsapp group.

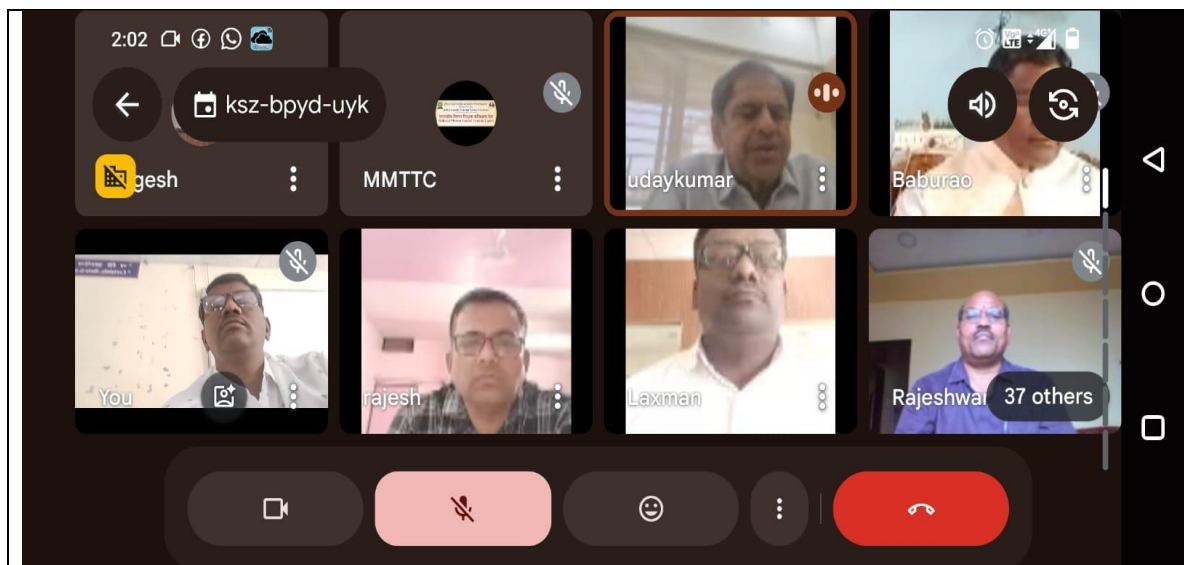
OUTCOMES OF PROGRAMME

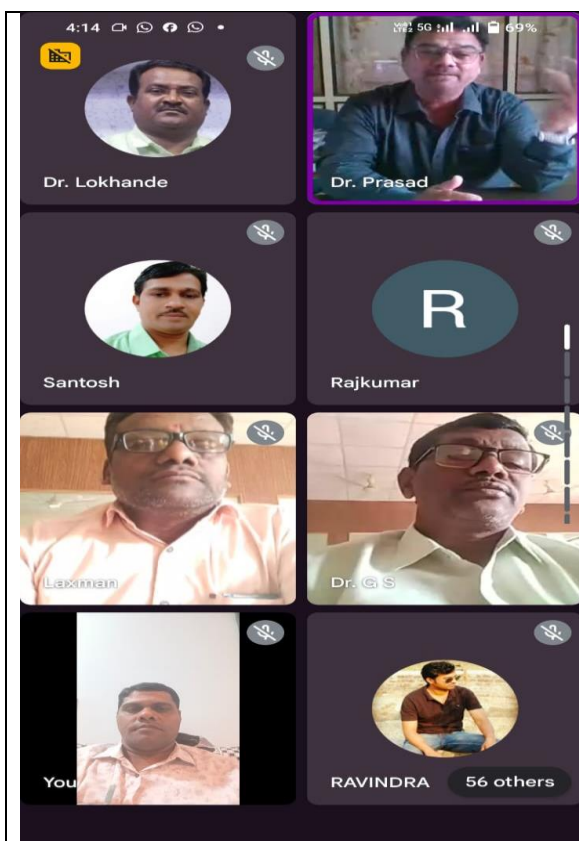

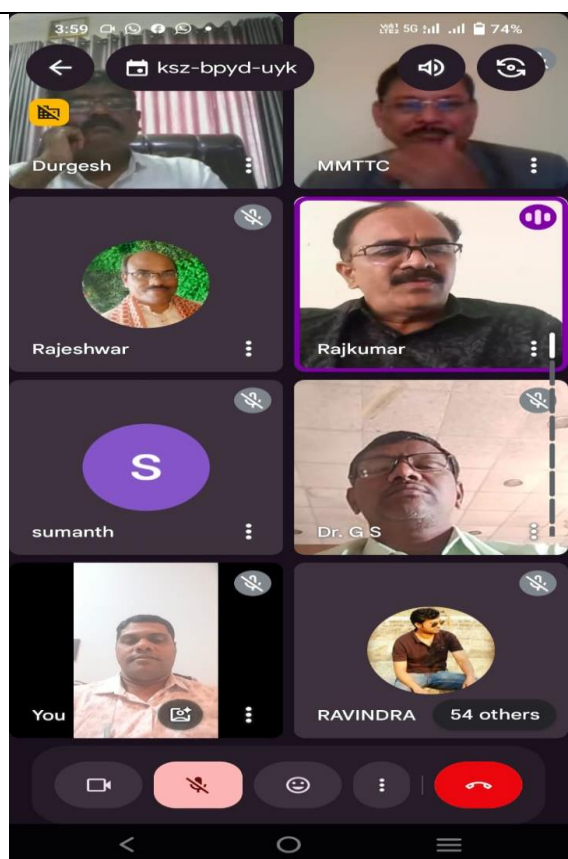

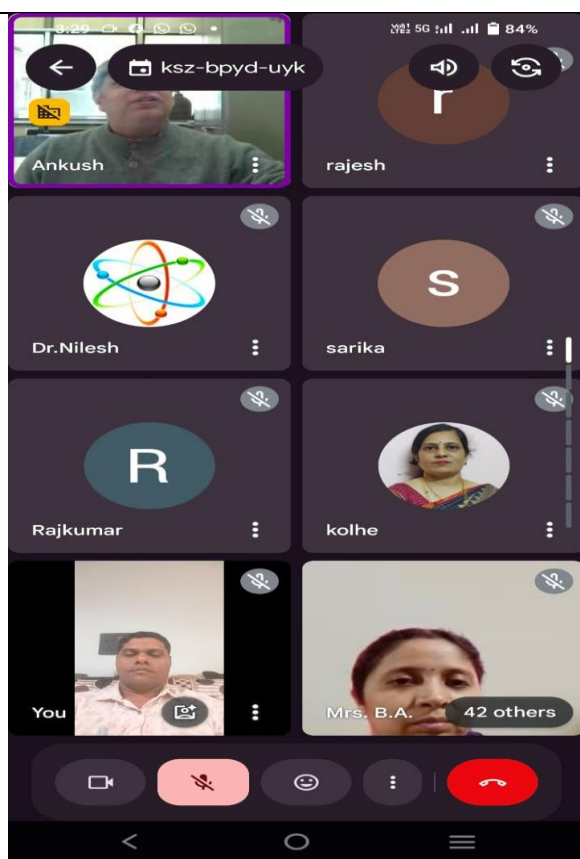

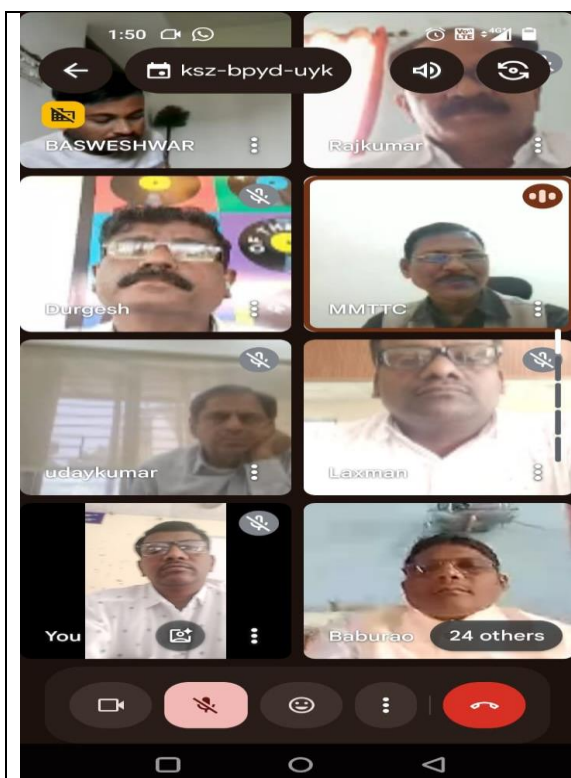

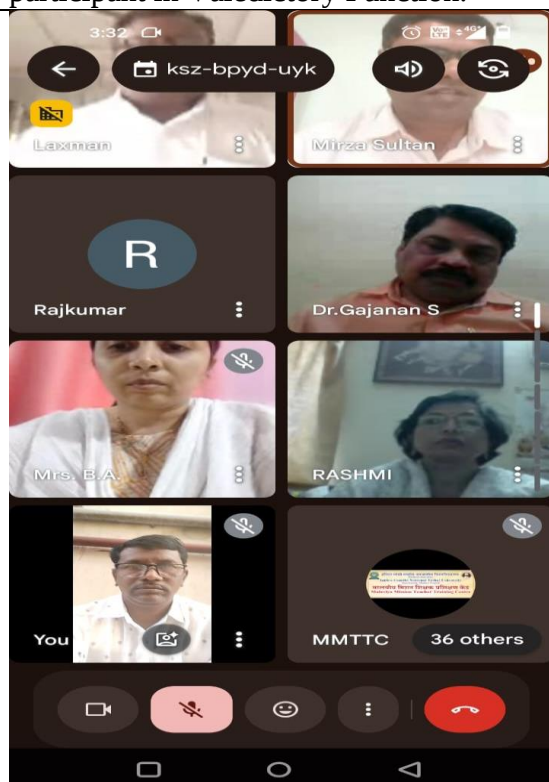

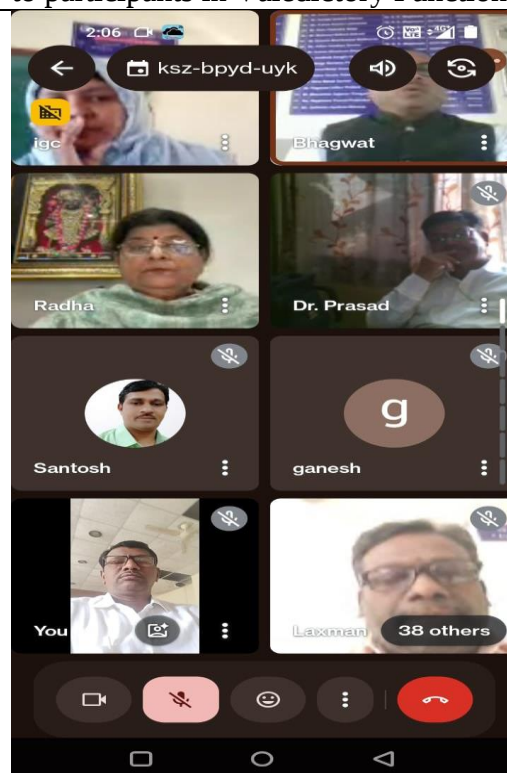
